



## “It’s Time for a Turn Around”

### **Texts: Psalm 30:1-12, Deuteronomy 30:15-16, 19, Joel 2:25-27**

No matter who we are and where we are in life right now, we’ve all needed a Turn Around, or a change, or a miracle, or a breakthrough, or a mighty move of the Spirit of God. In fact some of us need a major Turn Around right now, maybe in our finances, our business, our career, our marriage, our body or health, our ministry. Well, today is the day for our Turn Around if we’ll choose it, declare or decree it, and refuse to be denied. A Turn Around is a choice just like life is a choice that God has divinely ordained and empowered us to make through the divine supernatural life of Jesus that abides in our mortal physical flesh and body.

**II Corinthians 4:10 Always bearing about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our body.**

**11: For we which live are always delivered unto death for Jesus' sake, that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our mortal flesh.**

If God went as far as to say that life and death are choices, then a Turn Around is a choice too.

We can choose to give up, accept defeat, do

nothing and say nothing, or we can radically oppose our condition or circumstance, declare war against it and declare a day of Turn Around. There’s supernatural power in our radical decrees and declarations of Faith.

If we really want a Turn Around we must choose it instead of our current seemingly dead locked situation, and step into declaration mode.

**Job 22:28 Thou shalt also decree a thing, and it shall be established unto thee: and the light shall shine upon thy ways.**

**Mark 11:22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.**

**23: For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.**

See also Proverbs 12:14, Proverbs 13:2, Proverbs 21:23, Proverbs 6:2, Proverbs 18:20-21, matt 12:36-37.

**Deuteronomy 30:15 See, I have set before thee this day life and good, and death and evil;**

Notice carefully life is classified with and declared to be good and death classified with

and declared to be evil.

**19: I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live:**

In our text Psalm 30, David faced conditions that he needed a major turn around in. He needed a health turn around. He was facing death and needed a major turn a round from that. He was in a dark weeping place and needed a day break turn around. Maybe you’re in a similar situation and need a major turn around. It’s time to choose it and start declaring it.

**Psalm 30:2 O Lord my God, I cried unto thee, and thou hast healed me.**

David got a Turn Around in his health.

**3: O Lord, thou hast brought up my soul from the grave: thou hast kept me alive, that I should not go down to the pit.**

David got a turn around from the threat of death and going to the grave. See more mentions of this type of turn around in Psalm 49:15, Psalm 56:13, Psalm 116:8, Hosea 13:14. All of these verses declared a Turn Around deliverance from death and the grave.

In order to have a Turn Around in our life, we must have a turn around in certain areas of our life.

We must turn our thoughts around because our thoughts determine our confessions and declarations.

**Proverbs 23:7 For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he: Eat and drink, saith he to thee; but his heart is not with thee.**

We’ve got to choose to turn every negative thought of fear, doubt, defeat, failure, around to thoughts of courage, faith victory, success, prosperity, health and life. Then we’ll begin to declare, decree, and confess supernaturally empowered words of courage, faith, victory, success, prosperity, health, and life.

**Proverbs 12:14 A man shall be satisfied with good by the fruit of his mouth: and the recompence of a man's hands shall be rendered unto him.**

**Proverbs 21:23 Whoso keepeth his mouth and his tongue keepeth his soul from troubles.**

**Proverbs 18:20 A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth; and with the increase of his lips shall he be**

filled.

**21: Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.**

It’s Time for Your Turn Around so rise up and release your decree, declaration right now that your turn around from death to life is taking place right in whatever area you need it. Now **Turn Around 3 Times and Shout Hallelujah, Thank You Jesus.**

As we look a Job we see a man who needed a major turn around after being the greatest man in the east who feared God, was perfect and upright and hated evil. Also he was very wealthy, and had 10 children. In his test period he lost all and his wife told him to curse God and die. He eventually got a major Turn Around.

**Job 2:3 And the Lord said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? and still he holdeth fast his integrity, although thou movedst me against him, to destroy him without cause.**

**7: So went Satan forth from the presence of the Lord, and smote Job with sore boils from the sole of his foot unto his crown.**

**9: Then said his wife unto him, Dost thou still retain thine integrity? curse God, and die.**

Wow, talking about needing a Turn Around. Imagine your spouse telling you to give up, and also curse God, and die.

No matter who tells you to give up, hold on and declare, **It’s Time For a Turnaround** and speak it into existence. Job ignored his wife’s negative and discouraging suggestion and said to her.

**10: But he said unto her, Thou speakest as one of the foolish women speaketh. What? shall we receive good at the hand of God, and shall we not receive evil? In all this did not Job sin with his lips.**

In Chapter 33 we find Job in the most difficult time of his trial of suffering down to skin and bones, not able to eat, and facing the door of death and the grave. But we also see his turn around coming into being.

**Job 33:18 He keepeth back his soul from the pit, and his life from perishing by the sword.**

Please note that pit means grave.

**19: He is chastened also with pain upon**

his bed, and the multitude of his bones with strong pain:

**20: So that his life abhorreth bread, and his soul dainty meat.**

**21: His flesh is consumed away, that it cannot be seen; and his bones that were not seen stick out.**

**22: Yea, his soul draweth near unto the grave, and his life to the destroyers.**

He’s at the end of his natural physical life in appearance and facing the grave, but watch the supernatural turnaround and escaping the grave.

**24: Then he is gracious unto him, and saith, Deliver him from going down to the pit: I have found a ransom.**

See deliverance from the grave also in Psalm 49:15, Psalm 56:13, Psalm 116:8, and Hosea 13:14.

**25: His flesh shall be fresher than a child's: he shall return to the days of his youth:**

Wow a Turn Around from aging to youth restored and a turn around from the pit or grave in the next verses.

**28: He will deliver his soul from going into the pit, and his life shall see the**

light.

**29: Lo, all these things worketh God oftentimes with man,**

**30: To bring back his soul from the pit, to be enlightened with the light of the living.**

As long as you have breath in your body don’t give up because you’re a candidate for a Turn Around.

**I Samuel 2:6 The Lord killeth, and maketh alive: he bringeth down to the grave, and bringeth up.**

**7: The Lord maketh poor, and maketh rich: he bringeth low, and lifteth up.**

**8: He raiseth up the poor out of the dust, and lifteth up the beggar from the dunghill, to set them among princes, and to make them inherit the throne of glory: for the pillars of the earth are the Lord's, and he hath set the world upon them.**

It’s a major turn around going from the dung pile to being positioned with princes.

**Psalm 113:5 Who is like unto the Lord our God, who dwelleth on high,**

**6: Who humbleth himself to behold the things that are in heaven, and in the earth!**

**7: He raiseth up the poor out of the dust, and lifteth the needy out of the dunghill;**

**8: That he may set him with princes, even with the princes of his people.**

**9: He maketh the barren woman to keep house, and to be a joyful mother of children. Praise ye the Lord.**

No matter what you’ve been a victim of, **It’s Time For a Turnaround.**
