



## “Kingdom Rules for Kingdom Prosperity”

**Texts: Joshua 1:3-9, Psalm 1:1-3, Psalm 35:27, Job 8:5-7, Job 22:21-28**

Once we are born again, saved, and become a Kingdom citizen we become an Abraham seed heir to everything God’s Kingdom contains. We have entitlement rights to the supernatural Kingdom Prosperity. We also become candidates for supernatural success regardless of failures we’ve experienced prior to becoming a royal kingdom citizen. See 1 Peter 2:9 In order to experience the Kingdom Prosperity we have entitlement rights to we must learn and follow the Kingdom Rules for Kingdom Prosperity. We must learn all the divine promises and believe they belong to us, and will come through our Kingdom lives according to 11 Corinthians 1:20-21.

**Galatians 3:29 And if ye be Christ’s, then are ye Abraham’s seed, and heirs according to the promise.**

**11 Corinthians 1:20 For all the promises of God in Him are yea, and in Him Amen unto the glory of God by us.**

Even though we’re entitled to every promise made in God’s word they must come by us hearing them taught and receiving and believing them, and maintaining a constant confession of them out of our mouths as declared in Joshua 1:8.

**Joshua 1:6 Be strong and of a good courage: for unto this people shalt thou divide for an inheritance the land, which I swear unto their fathers to give them.**

Kingdom Rule for Kingdom Prosperity #1  
You must demonstrate the strength and courage God has given us through Jesus. The following verses are good references to encourage you in this area: Colossians 1:11, Ephesians 6:10-18, Ephesians 3:14-16, Psalm 27:1, 14.

Joshua 1 continued

**7: Only be thou strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law which Moses my servant commanded thee: turn not from it to the right hand or to the left, that thou mayest prosper whithersoever thou goest.**

**8: This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.**

Please note that the word meditate comes from the original Hebrew word haw-gaw, and means: to murmur, moan, mutter, roar, speak, talk, utter.

Notice how verse 9 re-emphasizes the

Kingdom Rule of being strong and courageous through your God empowered strength and courage.

**9: Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed for the Lord thy God is with thee withersoever thou goest.**

Kingdom Rule for Kingdom Prosperity #2  
Get all the Wisdom of God you can get, even if it requires correction. Solomon’s teachings clearly indicate there is supernatural success and prosperity contained in The Wisdom of God.

**Proverbs 3:11 My son, despise not the chastening of the Lord; neither be weary of His correction.**

**12: For whom the Lord loveth he correcteth; even as a father the son in whom he delighteth.**

**13: Happy is the man that findeth wisdom, and the man that getteth understanding.**

**14: For the merchandise of it is better than the merchandise of silver, and the gain thereof than fine gold.**

Wow! The wisdom of God generates silver and gold for those who get it and apply it to their lives.

**15: She is more precious than rubies and all the things thou canst desire are not to be compared unto her.**

**16: Length of days is in her right hand; and in her left hand riches and honour.**

**18: She is a tree of life to them that lay hold upon her: and happy is every one that retaineth her.**

Wow! The Wisdom of God also contains happiness if you obtain and keep it. Many people fail to realize that much of the Wisdom of God comes through the instruction that comes with the teaching of God’s word. When you neglect or fail to expose and avail yourself to the teaching of God’s word you hurt your chance of getting God’s Wisdom.

**Proverbs 8:10 Receive my instruction, and not silver; and knowledge rather than choice gold.**

**11: For wisdom is better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it.**

**12: I wisdom dwell with prudence and find out knowledge of witty inventions.**

**15: By me kings reign, and princes decree justice.**

**16: By me princes rule, and nobles, even all judges of the earth.**

**18: Riches and honour are with me: yea, durable riches and righteousness.**

**19: My fruit is better than gold, yea, than fine gold: and my revenue than choice silver.**

**21: That I may cause those that love me to inherit substance; and I will fill their treasures.**

Through these verses we can clearly see that the Wisdom of God causes tremendous kingdom prosperity and success.

### Kingdom Rule for Kingdom Prosperity #3

Make sure you are a Faith Follower of your spiritual leaders regardless of the obstacles and challenges you face. Sometimes it takes a jump start or Faith boost from someone else to get yours started. Your spiritual leaders have your divine inheritance and through their faith and the words they speak they cause you to get your inheritance. Notice this principle stated clearly in Deuteronomy 31:6-7.

**Deuteronomy 31:6 Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the Lord thy God, He it is that doth go with thee; He will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.**

**7: And Moses called unto Joshua, and said unto him in the sight of all Israel, Be strong and of a good courage: for thou must go with this people unto the land which the Lord hath sworn unto their fathers to give them, and thou shalt**

**cause them to inherit it.**

Those who continually follow the Faith of their spiritual leader ultimately get their divine kingdom inheritance, and prosperity.

**Hebrews 13:7 Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God whose Faith Follow, considering the end of their conversation.**

**Hebrews 6:9 But beloved, we are persuaded better things of you, and things that accompany salvation, though we thus speak.**

**10: For God is not unrighteous to forget you work and labour of love which ye have shewed toward his name, in that ye have ministered to the saints and do minister.**

**11: And we desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end.**

**12: That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.**

Follow the Faith and vision of your shepherd and spiritual leader and obtain the promises of God for your life and prosper.

### Kingdom Rule for Kingdom Prosperity #4

Operate with diligence at all times in all endeavors. Kingdom inheritance prosperity does not come from being lazy. You must be a self-starter, self-motivator, and self-encourager. Also remember that Faith without works is dead according to James 2:26. Your divine inheritance Kingdom Prosperity will not just drop in your lap, but must be ambitiously pursued with persistence, perseverance, passion, and patience. See Hebrews 10:35-39.

**Proverbs 6:6 Go to the ant, thou sluggard: consider her ways, and be wise.**

**7: Which having no guide overseer, or ruler,**

**8: Provideth her meat in the summer, and gathereth her food in the harvest.**

**9: How long will thou sleep, o sluggard? When wilt thou arise out of they sleep?**

**10: Yet a little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to sleep:**

**11: So shall thy poverty come as one that travelleth, and thy want as an armed man.**

Kingdom Rules for Kingdom Prosperity Followers don't sleep their lives away.

**Proverbs 10:4 He becometh poor that dealeth with a slack hand: but the hand of the diligent maketh rich.**

**5: He that gathereth in summer is a wise son: but he that sleepeth in harvest is a son that causeth shame.**

**Proverbs 20:13 Love not sleep, lest thou come to poverty; open thine, eyes, and thou shalt be satisfied with bread.**

**Proverbs 24:30 I went by the field of the slothful, and by the vineyard of the man void of understanding;**

**31: And, lo, it was all grown over with thorns, and nettles had covered the face thereof, and the stone wall thereof was broken down.**

**32: Then I saw, and considered it well: I looked upon it, and received instruction.**

**33: Yet a little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to sleep:**

**34: So shall thy poverty come as one that traveleth, and thy want as an armed man.**

### Kingdom Rule for Kingdom Prosperity #5

Maintain positive Faith filled word confessions regardless of obstacles, oppositions, and circumstances you face. Your Kingdom positive word confession causes Kingdom positive prosperity possession. You must realize that you'll never have more than you decree, confess, or command. Your words will make you, or break you, bless you, or curse you, satisfy you, or dis-satisfy you, give you life or

death.

**Mark 11:22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.**

**23: For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass: he shall have whatsoever he saith.**

**24: Therefore I say unto you, what things soever ye desire when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.**

You'll be satisfied in life based on your words.

**Proverbs 12:14 A man shall be satisfied with good by the fruit of his mouth: and the recompense of a man's hands shall be rendered unto him.**

What you eat or have in life depends on the words you speak. In the kingdom you must speak God's word continually to have what His word says you have.

**Proverbs 13:2 A man shall eat good by the fruit of his mouth: but the soul of the transgressors shall eat violence.**  
**3: He that keepeth his mouth keepeth his life: but he that openeth wide his lips**

**shall have destruction.**

**Proverbs 18:20 A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth; and with the increase of his lips shall he be filled.**

**21: Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit there of.**

For further insight into how damaging negative doubt filled words are and powerfully prosperous positive faith filled words are see: Matthew 12:34-37, Psalm 39:1, Psalm 141:3, and Job 6:24.

Kingdom Rule For Kingdom Prosperity #6

Give Your Faith a Job So It Can Work.

Unemployed, disabled, dormant, lazy Faith is dead and will keep you from experiencing your Kingdom Miracle Prosperity. Your Faith must be actively doing some work that corresponds with what you're believing for. See Peter in Matthew 14:22-36, The Shunammite woman in 11 Kings 4:8-37, The woman with the issue of blood in Matthew 9:18-31, and Mark 5:25-34, and The men carrying the paralyzed man in Mark 2:1-12.

Many times we miss out on things God wants for us because the supernatural God power and ability our Faith contains is not released because our Faith is dormant, inactive, or unemployed, with no works, or actions to make

it alive. We must realize that our works or corresponding actions reflecting our Faith verify, validate, substantiate, and prove our Faith exists.

Kingdom Rule For Kingdom Prosperity #7  
Give heed to, Believe, and hold onto The Law of Truth That Comes from The Lips of Your Priest. Your Kingdom Prosperity is in The Prophetic word they speak.

**Malachi 2:5 My covenant was with him of life and peace; and I gave them to him for the fear wherewith he feared me, and was afraid before my name.**

**6: The law of truth was in his mouth, and iniquity was not found in his lips: he walked with me in peace and equity, and did turn many away from iniquity.**

**7: For the priest's lips should keep knowledge, and they should seek the law at his mouth: for he is the messenger of the Lord of hosts.**

Also see 1 Samuel 1:1-20, and 1 Samuel 2:20-21, and how Hannah and her husband got miracle child Kingdom Prosperity by Giving heed to, believing, and holding onto the spoken word law of truth that come off the lips of their priest (Pastor).

Kingdom Rule for Kingdom Prosperity #8  
Seek God and the Kingdom diligently: Matt. 6:33, Heb. 11:6, Psalm 63:1-8.

Kingdom Rule For Kingdom Prosperity #9  
Walk in and maintain total obedience to God and His word at all times.

**Job 36:10 He openeth also their ear to discipline, and commandeth that they return from iniquity.**

**11: If they obey and serve him, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures.**

**12: But if they obey not, they shall perish by the sword, and they shall die without knowledge.**

**Deuteronomy 11: 8-9, 21-28.**

It's easy to be obedient to a principal or procedure or practical application process you've been given to do when it makes natural visible sense. But obeying something that doesn't make sense and you don't understand is a challenge. How bad do you want the results obedience causes eventually? Let's look at 2 poor desperate widow women being told to obey someone and something they had to do in their natural life to get supernatural results.

### Widow Woman #1

If you're so poor you're down to your last meal before dying, what sense does it make to give a total stranger your last meal just because he told you to.

**I Kings 17:11 And as she was going to fetch it, he called to her, and said, Bring me, I pray thee, a morsel of bread in thine hand.**

**12: And she said, As the Lord thy God liveth, I have not a cake, but an handful of meal in a barrel, and a little oil in a cruse: and, behold, I am gathering two sticks, that I may go in and dress it for me and my son, that we may eat it, and die.**

Sometimes we make excuses for why we don't just obey what we're supposed to do, that will get us supernatural results. Satan doesn't want us to obey because the results will destroy his attack on our life. So he does all he can to block our minds from obedience.

**13: And Elijah said unto her, Fear not; go and do as thou hast said: but make me thereof a little cake first, and bring it unto me, and after make for thee and for thy son.**

**14: For thus saith the Lord God of Israel, The barrel of meal shall not waste,**

**neither shall the cruse of oil fail, until the day that the Lord sendeth rain upon the earth.**

Now he's telling her the supernatural results of provision she'll get if she just obeys him. Also notice in the next verse what she would have missed out on if she didn't obey.

**15: And she went and did according to the saying of Elijah: and she, and he, and her house, did eat many days.**

She went from one day's provision to many days provision because she obeyed.

**16: And the barrel of meal wasted not, neither did the cruse of oil fail, according to the word of the Lord, which he spake by Elijah.**

### Widow Woman #2

Now what kind of sense does it make to go borrow empty pots from all your neighbors to solve a serious debt and financial problem?

**II Kings 4:3 Then he said, Go, borrow thee vessels abroad of all thy neighbours, even empty vessels; borrow not a few.**

How's borrowing empty things going to solve problems you have of empty finances?

**4: And when thou art come in, thou shalt shut the door upon thee and upon thy sons, and shalt pour out into all those vessels, and thou shalt set aside that which is full.**

**5: So she went from him, and shut the door upon her and upon her sons, who brought the vessels to her; and she poured out.**

**6: And it came to pass, when the vessels were full, that she said unto her son, Bring me yet a vessel. And he said unto her, There is not a vessel more. And the oil stayed.**

**7: Then she came and told the man of God. And he said, Go, sell the oil, and pay thy debt, and live thou and thy children of the rest.**

Look at the supernatural miraculous debt cancellation and prosperity for life she would have missed if she would not have been obedient to what she was told to do.

Also see II Kings 5:9-14 and how Naaman almost missed out on his miraculous healing when he refused to be obedient, but then obey.
