



## “Total Confidence in The Power of God’s Word”

### **Texts: Hebrews 10:35-39, Proverbs 4:20-22, Isaiah 55:10-11**

According to John 1:1, God and His word have co-existed as the same eternally evolving entity since the beginning of existence. Therefore, whatever power God is and has, His word is and has the same unlimited power. We must channel our Faith, Trust, and Total Confidence in the eternal and unlimited power of God’s word. We must look carefully at what the scriptures say specifically about what God’s word can do and cause to happen no matter how long it takes to manifest.

**John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.**

**2: The same was in the beginning with God.**

**3: All things were made by him; and without him was not anything made that was made.**

In essence this verse says that all things were made by God’s word since He and His word are the same entity. So then, God’s word is creative. It can, when spoken with Total Confidence create whatever it says in the Bible. Whatever is written or documented can be spoken into natural existence or manifestation if one has Total Confidence in the Power of the word they speak, command, or decree. See

also Job 22:28 and Mark 11:22-24.

Everything that God created He did so by speaking the word of it into the atmosphere. We are made in His very image and create things into the natural atmosphere realm by speaking His word with Boldness and Confidence. See also Hebrews 11:1-6.

**Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.**

**2: And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.**

**3: And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.**

**4: And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness.**

**5: And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.**

**6: And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters.**

**7: And God made the firmament, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament: and it was so.**

**8: And God called the firmament Heaven. And the evening and the morning were the second day.**

### **STUDY NOTES**



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God continued to create by His words all the way to verse 26 when He said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. In essence God created us to function just like Him in the earth by having dominion over everything by our words that we speak that are the same as His word recorded in the Bible. See also John 14:12.

Everything God spoke to obeyed God, everything that Jesus spoke to obeyed Him, and since we are as He is in this world according to I John 4:17 everything we speak to should obey us. See Matthew 21:18-22, and Mark 11:12-14, 20-24, and Genesis 1:1-26.

Since God’s word and He are both eternal and the same, God’s word endures forever just as God does. God’s word has all power just as He does and can do anything if believed, held onto confidently, and spoken boldly. It will never return to God void or empty but will always contain and produce all it says. It will also prosper who God sends it to. See also Matt. 24:35, and I Pet. 1:25.

**Isaiah 55:10 For as the rain cometh**

**down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater:**

**11: So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.**

The word accomplish comes from the Hebrew word *aw-saw* and means: to create, to labor, to toil, to spring forth, to make happen.

The devil fights us hard to keep us from receiving, believing, and maintaining by Faith and Confident Confession God’s word because he knows it’s as powerful as God is and will come to pass as God in Jeremiah 1:12 performs it for those who keep declaring it.

The devil knows that God’s word is life and health to us when we find it. That’s why he continually tries to wear us down with situations and circumstances to distract us from the truth of God’s word. He knows the truth of God’s word will free us from his attempts to steal, kill, and destroy us. See also John 8:32 and what Jesus said about truth, and Proverbs 4:20-22 and how God’s word gives life and health.

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We must be like our bosom father Abraham and not stagger but be boldly confident in the Power of God’s Word, especially since we know His word is Him. See in Romans 4:13-25 how Abraham had total confidence in God’s covenant promise word, was fully persuaded, and even ignored his and his wife’s bodies which were like dead as far as being able to do what God said they could and would do.

**Romans 4:17 (As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were.**

**18: Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be.**

**19: And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sarah's womb:**

**20: He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God;**

**21: And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.**

God’s word says in Jeremiah 32:17 & 27 that nothing is too hard for Him, and in Ephesians 3:20 He’s able to do exceeding abundantly above all we ask or think. In order to Turn Your Tomb into Your Womb and conceive and give birth and life to what was or is dead you must speak the word to it like Jesus did in John 11:21-27, 35-45.

In Genesis 1:1-26 everything that God spoke to became into natural visible existence. Also everything that Jesus spoke to became what He spoke to it to become or even to cease to exist.

Jesus told His disciples and us that things they and we speak to would become what we speak or cease to be based on what we speak.

**Matthew 21:18 Now in the morning as he returned into the city, he hungered.**

**19: And when he saw a fig tree in the way, he came to it, and found nothing thereon, but leaves only, and said unto it, Let no fruit grow on thee henceforward forever. And presently the fig tree withered away.**

**20: And when the disciples saw it, they marveled, saying, How soon is the fig tree withered away!**

**21: Jesus answered and said unto them,**

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**Verily I say unto you, If ye have faith, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done.**

**22: And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.**

Notice carefully the text starts with Jesus speaking to the tree and it obeying Him, but concludes with Jesus telling His disciples that they could speak to the tree and the mountain without having doubt and they would do what was spoken to them. This strongly suggests that we that believe on Jesus as John 14:12 says can do the same things. Look what Jesus said to His disciples when they asked Him to increase their faith. He told them their problem wasn't lack of faith, but lack of speaking to things and telling them what to do. To a certain extent that's our problem too.

**Luke 17:5 And the apostles said unto the Lord, Increase our faith.**

**6: And the Lord said, If ye had faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you.**

In the next verses Jesus refers to speaking to a

mountain. But in actuality we can speak to financial lack, sickness, career problems, business problems, marriage problems, or anything that seems to be blocking our deliverances, success, breakthrough or victory.

**Mark 11:22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.**

**23: For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.**

**24: Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.**

Let's look at some examples of bible people who put tremendous faith, stock, and total confidence in the power of God's word spoken to them concerning their circumstance, problem, and condition. Matthew 8:5-13 the centurion and his sick servant, and I Samuel 1:13-20, and I Sam 2:20-21, Hannah and her miracle child she received.

The centurion had total confidence in the spoken word having enough supernatural God power to miraculously heal his servant.

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**Matthew 8:5** And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto him a centurion, beseeching him,  
**6:** And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented.

**7:** And Jesus saith unto him, I will come and heal him.

**8:** The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldst come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed.

**10:** When Jesus heard it, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.

**13:** And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.

To see more on the supernatural power of the spoken word see Hannah receive her long sought after miracle when she heard, received, and believed the miracles seed word spoken by her man of God priest and pastor Eli in I Samuel 1:1-20. Also in I Samuel 2:20-21 her same man of God Eli the priest and pastor spoke a miracle seed word to she and her husband and they had five more children.

**I Samuel 1:17** Then Eli answered and said, Go in peace: and the God of Israel grant thee thy petition that thou hast asked of him.

**18:** And she said, Let thine handmaid find grace in thy sight. So the woman went her way, and did eat, and her countenance was no more sad.

**20:** Wherefore it came to pass, when the time was come about after Hannah had conceived, that she bare a son, and called his name Samuel, saying, Because I have asked him of the Lord.

**I Samuel 2:20** And Eli blessed Elkanah and his wife, and said, The Lord give thee seed of this woman for the loan which is lent to the Lord. And they went unto their own home.

**21:** And the Lord visited Hannah, so that she conceived, and bare three sons and two daughters. And the child Samuel grew before the Lord.

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
